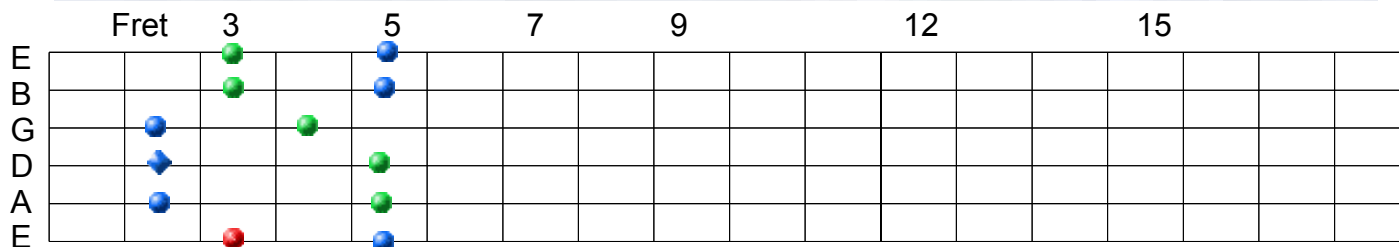
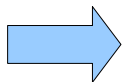




5 pentatonic scale shapes in the key of G major / E minor

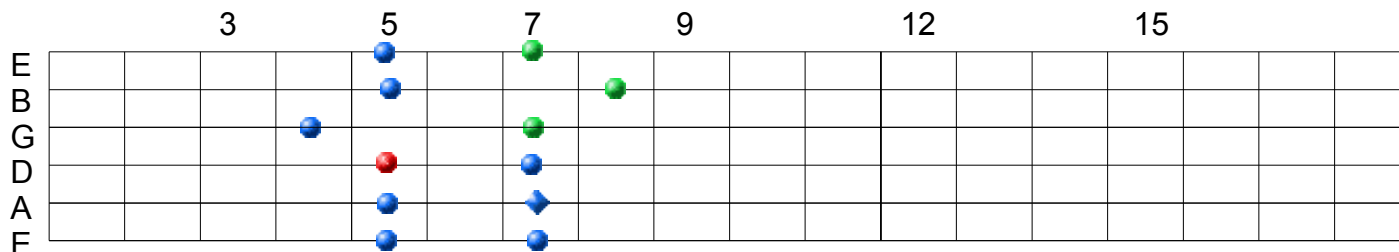
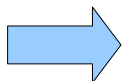
1st position.

G major chord with the root on the low E string



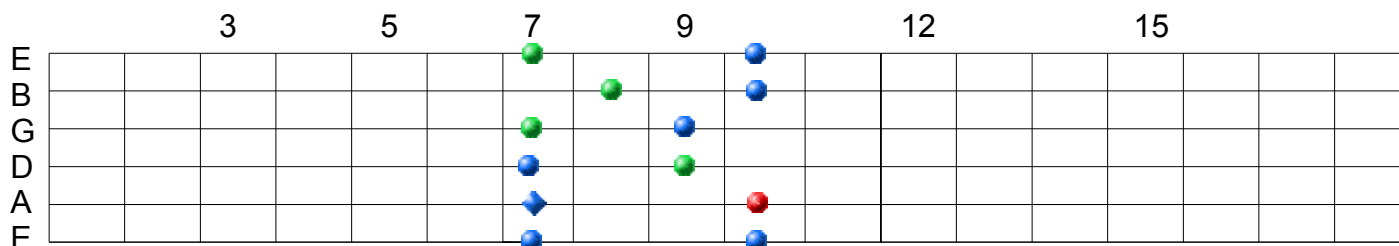
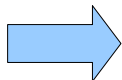
2nd position

G major Chord



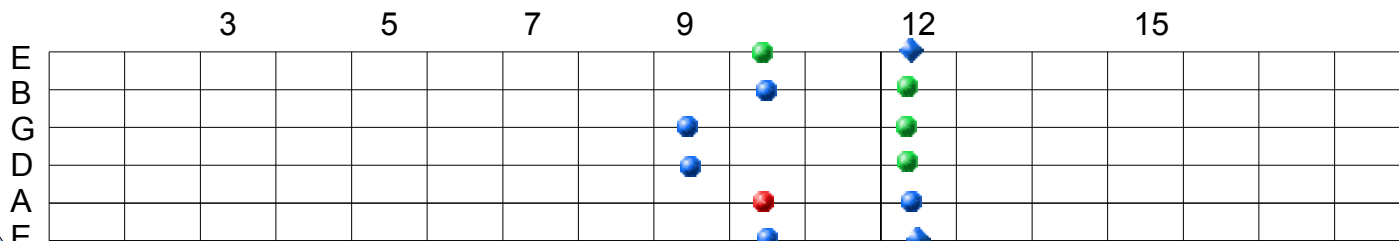
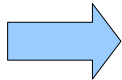
3rd position

G major Chord



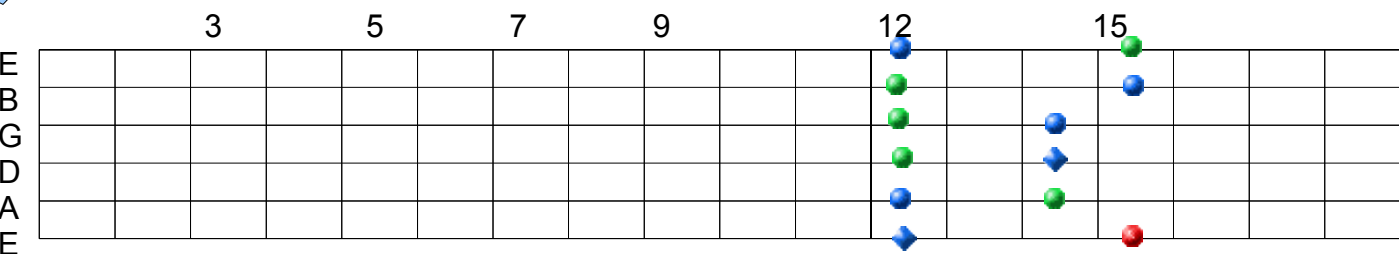
4th position

● Root note of major chord/scale

● When added to the root note makes a major chord

◆ Relative minor root. Gmajor – Eminor this helps you view the scale over minor chords.

● Notes that when added to the major chord form the pentatonic scale
