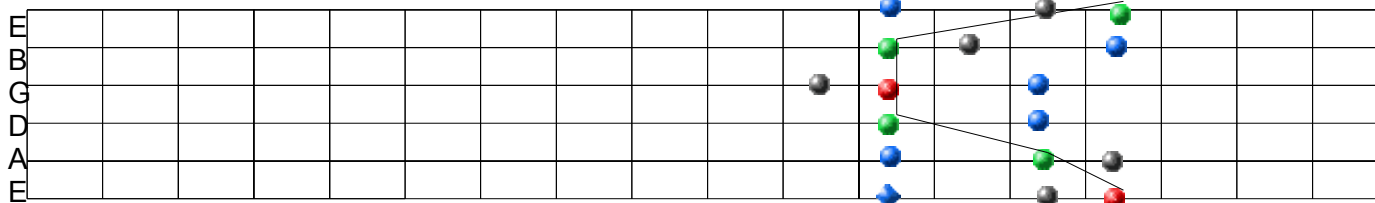

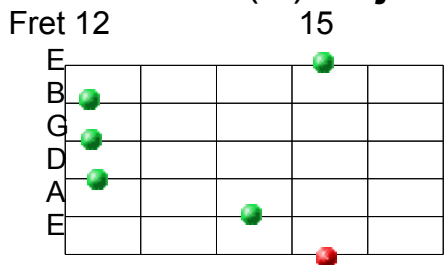
G major scale with the root on the 6th string

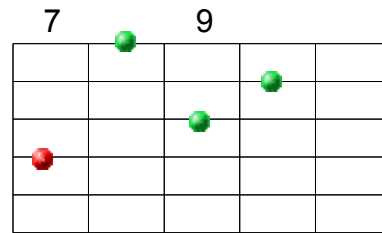
